To calculate square inches:

Measure quilt top length & width.

Multiply length by width.

Example: $81W \times 96L = 7776$ square

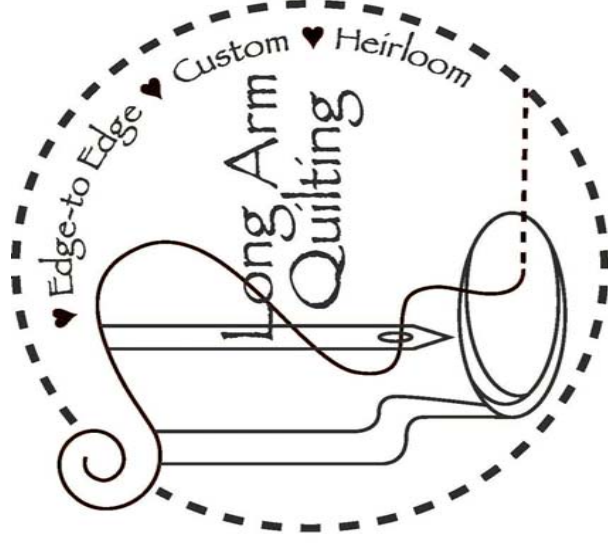
To calculate linear inches:

Measure quilt top width & length

Add width + length, multiply by 2

Example: $81W + 96L = 177x2 = 354$

Is Your Quilt Ready?

Use this handy check list for your convenience

(An additional fee will be charged for each of the following services that must be performed on your quilt)

All 3 layers separate- no basting or pins please

Top:

___ loose threads trimmed

___ well pressed

___ seam direction checked

___ no wavy borders

___ squared corners

___ back stitch all outside seams

___ all repairs done, no open seams

___ mark "TOP" with safety pin

___ no embellishments please

Backing:

___ no sheets please

___ "priny" to hide threads

___ colors match quilt top

___ selvages trimmed or clipped

___ 1/2" seams pressed open

___ well pressed

___ ends straightened & squared

___ mark "TOP" with safety pin

___ at least 6" larger than top

Batting:

___ can purchase from Pat
"Quilter's Dream"

(cotton, blend, poly, flame retardant, puff, wool & all new "Green Batting")

___ proper type for your quilt

___ wash & dry cotton & blend

___ air fluff poly to remove creases

___ at least 6" larger than top
